Whatever the format, all workshops should be interactive events and ample time should be allocated to discussion. The typical duration for a workshop is one full day, but two-day or half-day workshops can also be accommodated.

- Title and acronym.

- One paragraph about each organizer (scientific profile, previous events you have organized, ...).
- Short description of the Workshop, containing a brief introduction and list of relevant topic areas, workshop intended format and duration (half-day until two-days). Please indicate if you intend to have any activities other than contributed papers, such as invited talks, panels, posters, ...
- Audience: research groups working in the field, tentative list of potentially interested participants, expected number of submissions.
- Previous editions of the workshop if applicable; related workshops in other venues
- Any further information you deem to be relevant.
